**Changes to Mass Times:**

Over the past year, Derby Deanery has re-visited the 'You are Living Stones' proposals of November 2013, and after consultation, including analyzing the questionnaires that we completed in September last year, they have proposed that St Alban's, The Church on Oakwood and St Hugh's are clustered with Ralph Sherwin, Chellaston and English Martyrs, Alvaston. The number of priests looking after these 5 churches has been reduced from 3 to 2. Consequently, the number of weekend masses across the 5 churches will be reduced from 7 to 5 to make it more manageable for one priest to cover when necessary. Sadly the 6.30pm masses on Saturday evenings at St Alban's and at English Martyrs will no longer continue after July 8<sup>th</sup> 2017. We want to keep as many people as possible coming to celebrate Mass at one of our churches, so please contact the Parish Office if you require a lift, or are able to offer anyone a lift to any of the other masses. Anyone that is on a Ministry rota; readers, welcomers, altar servers, ushers Eucharistic ministers, etc, please contact the office or your rota coordinator to continue your ministry at another mass time. Please be assured that you will be made to feel welcome at all masses, and that you are very much in our prayers at this time of change and opportunity.
