

Mathematics

In the first half term, Children in both 3 and 4 will explore place value in numbers. They will learn Roman numeral representations and how to round to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. The children are expected to continue to learn their times tables and will have a weekly times table quiz on a Tuesday. In the second half of the term, we will look at addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

French

Mrs Mendonca will teach French in each class on a Thursday. This term the Y3s will be learning about French greetings, numbers to 20 and items around the classroom whilst Y4 will begin to look at expressing feelings, numbers to 30 and having conversations in French.

Religious Education

We will be following the Come and See scheme of work, and we will be focusing on our topics of, 'Homes, Visitors and Called.' There will also be a week focussing on Judasim.

Science

During science lessons the children will learn about the scientific names of the body and how to fuel our bodies correctly. They will also learn the functions of the different teeth and how to keep them healthy Please see the knowledge organiser in the children's home-learning book for specific knowledge that the children can practise at home.

PSHE

During R-Time the children will get to know each other. They will recognise the importance of respecting each other in order to understand how to work together effectively, in any lesson, to maximise learning.

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History/Geography

We will look at famous athletes of the past who have influenced history.

Using a map, we will locate the leisure facilities in Derby and refine our sketch mapping skills at Chaddesden Park.

History/Geography

English

English grammar skills, handwriting, punctuation and spelling will be taught daily. We will centre our learning round a range of quality texts starting with Roald Dahl's 'Matilda' and moving to Anthony Brown's, 'Voices in the Park.' The children will also be writing an explanation text that will link to their learning on how to be healthy.

D&T / Art

We will be basing our study on Leonardo De Vinichi and learning how to draw a portrait. The children will also have the opportunity to create a healthy snack,

Computing

In Computing we will be looking at how to keep safe on the internet as well as how to find reliable research and present this electronically.
