

Mathematics

Children in both 3 and 4 will explore addition, subtraction, multiplication and division strategies using resources as well as written methods. The children will then be able to apply these to a range of problems. Additional practise at recalling a range of number bonds of numbers up to 19 will help the children work more efficiently. The children are expected to continue to learn their times tables and will have a weekly times table quiz.

French

This term the Y3s will learn about items around the classroom, months of the year and numbers to 30. Y4 will begin to look at different shops, asking to buy items with emphasis on conversational French.

Religious Education

We will be following the Come and See scheme of work. For the first week, we will look at Judaism and explore the similarities and differences between the two religions. We will then move on to the topics, 'Visitors.'

Science

During science lessons the children will learn to compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. They will describe how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

History/Geography


Children will learn about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

This includes, studying the late Neolithic hunter-gatherers and early farmers. The children will compare homes today to those at Skara Brea and understand how climate affects how houses are built. They will locate Stonehenge using a map and understand its spiritual importance during the Stone age and also understand why it is a world heritage site today.

PSHE

During R-Time the children explore strategies on how to manage a range of emotions, how to build and maintain friendships and how to settle differing opinions effectively.

English

Spelling, punctuation and grammar will continue to be taught daily. These aspects of English will be incorporated into our quality text which will be, 'Stig of the Dump.' The children will use their skills to create an effective setting description.

They will then move on to persuasion nearer Christmas and learn how to advertise a product using persuasive vocabulary.

D&T / Art

We will create cave painting designs as well as sculpting an artefact from the era out of clay. There will also be some Christmas arts and crafts.
