Our School and Traditional Tales

At St. Alban's we are proud of our dedication to the prime and specific areas of learning. We encourage child-led learning for the majority of our school day, and provide stimulating provision during this time both indoors and out in all weathers.

Physical Development

Alongside a physically challenging outdoor area, our provision is carefully planned with physical development in mind. In PE we will be experimenting with different ways of moving and using equipment to balance and travel under, over, around and through.

Literacy

We will have a new book or rhyme of the week, and will use this as a base for our exploration and continuous provision. We will provide lots of opportunities for children to experiment with mark making and books.

Religious Education

In the Autumn term we talk about ourselves, our families and our friends. We learn about Baptism and the birth of Jesus.



Phonics

We will explore a new sound each day and look at the shape, the sound and relevant objects. Promoting segmenting and blending skills to read.

Communication and Language

Using smaller key worker groups we give our children many opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills. We ensure that all children feel listened to and have a good experience of early literature.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We ensure that our children and families feel supported from the start, so that they are able to come into FS2 feeling confident to try new things. We will be looking at the rules and expectations in school. As well as promoting positive relationships between children and staff.

Mathematics

We will be looking at numbers of personal significance and recognising and counting with numbers 1-10 through addition and subtraction. We will also learn about 2D shapes and money.
