All about me

At St. Alban's Nursery we are proud of our dedication to the prime and specific areas of learning. We encourage child-led learning for the majority of our school day, and provide stimulating provision during this time both indoors and out in all weathers.

Physical Development

Alongside a physically challenging outdoor area, our provision is carefully planned with physical development in mind. We provide Dough Disco and Squiggle as you Wiggle sessions which promote fine motor and early writing skills.

Literacy

We will have a new book or rhyme of the week each week, and will use this as a base for our exploration and continuous provision.

Religious Education

In the Autumn term we talk about ourselves, our families and our friends. We learn about Baptism and the birth of Jesus.



Phonics

We will explore a new letter each week and look at the shape, the sound and relevant objects.

Communication and Language

Using smaller key worker groups we give our children many opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills. We ensure that all children feel listened to and have a good experience of early literature.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We ensure that our children and families feel supported from the start, so that they are able to come into nursery feeling confident to try new things. We promote and support good behaviour choices, and encourage children to think about their friends as well as themselves in the choices that they make.

Mathematics

We will have a number of the week each week. We will use CBeebies Number blocks to help us to remember and understand the numbers.
