Read the statements below and answer whether they are factual or bluff by writing their corresponding numbers on the FACT or BLUFF box.

1. The Treaty of Versailles was signed on June 28, 1919, in the Hall of Mirrors in the Palace of Versailles, France.
2. The Treaty of Versailles was a peace treaty signifying the end of the First World War between the Triple Alliance and Triple Entente.
3. United States, Russia, Italy, and Great Britain were known as the 'Big Four'.
4. Article 1081 was known as the War Guilt Clause.
5. First World War's loss and damage were assessed amounting to \$33 billion in 1921 (US \$442 billion in 2017).
6. Manufacturing of airplanes, submarines, tanks, and armoured cars was also forbidden in Germany.
7. Poland was demilitarized and 50 kilometers (30 miles) east of the river was considered as a demilitarized zone.
8. The Big Four wanted to assure that Germany would never again become a military threat.
9. The Treaty of Versailles developed deep resentment from the Germans.
10. Germany's economy was devastated and paved to the development of fascism in the country in the 1930s.
